ATTENTION: Childhood Cancer Warriors



Trailblazing to Protect Our Warriors' Hearts

Sofia's Hope is considered the leading funder in pediatric cardio-oncology. When we first began this partnership 8 years ago with Dr. Steven Lipshultz, the world's leading authority on the topic, we helped to fund a Clinical Research Coordinator to conduct educational outreach like presentations and journal articles. Then the work stretched to create the first-ever bio-medical journal focused on the topic, Cardio-Oncology. We then moved into quarterly educational webinars and finally launched the First International Pediatric Cardio-Oncology Conference last fall. The second conference is slated for 2024, and now our sights are set on establishing a first-ever Fellowship for Pediatric Cardio-Oncology.

We are making incredible progress toward our goals. President and Founder, Marta Blanco, shared at the spring Wine & Cheese event, "This partnership means so much to Sofia's Hope and me personally—I know because of the research that we can honestly say we have helped save the lives of children facing a cancer diagnosis. Besides my children it is my proudest accomplishment." There is much to do, but we will continue trailblazing to protect our warriors' hearts.



Letter from the President

Dear Friend,

Happy Childhood Cancer Awareness Month! September is always an incredible time for our community to spotlight the plight of childhood cancer and raise awareness and support of this all-important cause.



As you know, Sofia's Hope turned 10 in January, and we have been celebrating all year long. It's been a bittersweet journey for me – from grieving mother with a fierce hope to give back to President of an organization that has provided over \$1M in support to the pediatric cancer community. I truly believe that Sofia has organized people along my path to grow Sofia's Hope.

- A friend of a friend who saw a Facebook post, called me early on to announce he was going to adopt Sofia's Hope as his company's charity of choice.
 Ten years later, Jamie Doherty of R2 UnifiedTechnologies serves as Vice President on the Sofia's Hope Board, donates quarterly as a corporate sponsor, and organizes the annual Denim & Diamonds event.
- Melissa Wetzel and I had a connection from the start. She listened and accepted all of me—my hopes for the organization, my pain and emotional scars, my fear to put myself and my girls out there, and my determination to make a difference—and slowly worked alongside of me to teach me how to fundraise, and to have the courage to tell our collective story to inspire a community of support. Melissa, who is now our Director of Development, has raised nearly \$300,000 for the cause.
- When I first met with Peg Hairston of the Miami Cancer Institute at Baptist Health in 2018, she gave me the chance to dream about what more we could do.
 MCI has funded our Field Trips programs to Zoo Miami and Whispering Manes ever since providing beautiful experiences and memories for our patients and families. Under Patty Gaona Hernandez's leadership, the partnership continues to expand into the Newly Diagnosed Family Kits and Treasured Moments.

There are simply too many names to list here, but I pray that I have shown my gratitude to each and every one of you throughout this journey. It is only together that we support almost 2,000 children and families each year throughout all of South Florida and beyond!

Sofia's Hope may have begun with the Blanco family, but it has become something much bigger...here's to you, our dear village, and here's to Sofia's Hope!

Voice of the Patient Report


On June 15th, the Children's Cancer Cause published their Voice of the Patient Report on Reducing Cardiac Late Effects in Survivors. The report stems from an Externally led Patient-Focused Drug Development (EL-PFDD) meeting on reducing cardiac late effects in pediatric cancer survivors, held in September 2022. This virtual meeting was an opportunity for childhood cancer survivors and caregivers to speak to the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and other experts about the need to develop new drugs that protect the heart and reduce cardiac late effects caused by harsh chemotherapy and radiation treatments.

Sofia's Hope Founder and President, Marta Blanco, was one of those invited to share Sofia's story and is proud to be a voice for so many childhood cancer survivors facing these issues.

> "I learned to advocate for Sofia at every turn and continue doing so today. I think it's important for oncologists and cardiologists to be better prepared to see and treat other Sofia's. They need to know how to diagnose them properly, early and provide the best treatment possible. Ultimately, what we truly need are effective, less toxic cancer treatments that don't include anthracyclines. And if a cardio-protective agent had been available in 2003, Sofia could be alive today with or without less severe cardiac issues. Either way she would've had a better chance for a longer, more impactful life."
