Letter from the President

Dear Friend,

There is no simple way to sum up the past year. Tumultuous, frightening, wearisome. Resilient, heroic, hopeful. I think we will choose to proceed with hopeful!

Regardless of the events going on around us, Sofia's Hope was undeterred in our mission to support children with cancer and their families. We quickly pivoted our programs to virtual platforms, "Zooming", and making use of FaceTime and WhatsApp like never before. We extended the deadline for our program to give applicants more time and awarded a total of six scholarships. We adapted our equestrian program to offer one-on-one, private sessions for patients and their siblings versus camp. We were even able to expand our patient and family programing by offering a free, virtual tutoring program, Study Buddies.

And we have to acknowledge our program sponsors starting with The Kirk Foundation who not only maintained their level of support of our art programs but increased it. And to Baptist Health South Florida/Miami Cancer Institute for their ongoing commitment to our Equestrian and Zoo Field Trip programs. Support for our Newly Diagnosed Family Kits was provided by a grant from the Coral Gables Community Foundation as well as the Awesome Foundation. We also received grants for our Treasured Moments program, specifically for gift cards, from Spotlight Miami and The Kirk Foundation.

The Miami Foundation, the Office of the Mayor of Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners and the Miami-Dade County Department of Public Housing and Community Development funding, made possible from the federal Coronavirus Relief Funds, was used to cover business interruption costs, reopening, and other expenses related to COVD-19. Without the support of all these partners, Sofia's Hope would not have been able to provide the support we did in 2020!

So, while 2020 was not what any of us were expecting, it has made us realize that like kids facing childhood cancer, we are tougher than we think we are. Patience is, indeed, a virtue, but so is persistence and open mindedness. For 2021, we expect to continue moving forward with even greater optimism and hope. We look forward to the day we can go back to in-person programming and events, to being able to celebrate the Sofia's Hope community, face to face, and say thanks!

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Calling all DAFs



A Doll's Journey Partnership and 2021 Expansion

Since 2019, Sofia's Hope has partnered with Muriel Rivero and A Doll's Journey to bring over 30 young girls their own American Girl "Truly Me" doll. These dolls have been very well received as they help remind these warriors that their beautiful bald heads are badges of honor to be worn with pride.

So much so, that this year we will be expanding the program to offer young boys (and girls) their own Timeless Teddy Bear from Build-A-Bear. All of our young warriors are our heroes and inspiration, and we hope these new friends bring them joy and comfort now and always.



Study Buddies: A Free Tutoring Service

Our Study Buddies tutoring program was established in 2020 to help children with cancer, survivors and their siblings with their math and science schoolwork. Many children affected by cancer develop learning disabilities due to treatment and many have to leave school. We want to help them stay on track with their studies and help them succeed.

To ensure safety and maintain social distancing rules, all tutoring will be done through Zoom or FaceTime. The program idea was brought forward and is now lead by Maria Mantero, who has worked as a tutor for five years, helping 10 families and 15 children with their math and science courses.

Virtual Visits to Zoo and ClayWorld Art Projects A Success

Our bi-annual field trips to Zoo Miami became interactive virtual sessions where patients, their siblings and other family members learned about various animals from Grant Fischer, Education Program Manager at Zoo Miami.

Our first session in December was all about the Florida Panther, the silent predator that almost went extinct and is slowly making a comeback through conservation. In January we learned about giraffes and last month about apes. We also added sessions of clay art fun with Jorge Cruz from ClayWorld so that each participant could make their own, unique clay animal souvenir. Overall, over 60 patients and their family members participated, some as far away as Los Angeles!









COVID Does Not Stop Equestrian Program!

In the past year, we have provided twenty-seven patients or siblings with individual, private horseback riding lessons at Whispering Manes Therapeutic Riding Center. Participants groomed their horse, learned about horsemanship and received horseback riding lessons.

Healing Arts Art Therapy Program

Eliane Cristian, our licensed creative art therapist, continues providing patients and siblings with a safe environment via FaceTime and WhatsApp for them to express their feelings and heal through art. Together they have done healing mandalas, drawn their spirit animals and feelings pictures, discussed Wish vacations, and so much more. While we would love for sessions to be done in-person, we continue to see the value of these virtual sessions which is why we now offer eight sessions a month, with two one Saturday a month.



Progress Update: 2021 Sofia's Hope College Scholarships

In mid-January, Sofia's Hope opened this year's application cycle for both the Sofia and Gabriela Blanco College Scholarships through a new online portal which offers students and the organization alike the ability to easily organize application information, and submit completed applications with a touch of a button.

We are offering six (6) total scholarships—three to patients/survivors and three to siblings. Each scholarship offers recipients \$2,000 toward tuition or room and board, along with a laptop (first-time awardees only), made possible through our partner, R2 United Technologies.

Over 140 applications were submitted by our April 1, 2021. The awardees will be advised by May 1st. Please help us spread the word, and if you plan to submit an application, good luck!





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
